- Continue to <u>Koh Klang</u> a quiet place away from the tourist rush in Krabi province, with very few tourists. Many of the villagers are fishermen and boatmen just outside the town of Krabi lies one of Krabi's richest natural wonders: kilometres of pristine Mangrove Forest.
- Free time and leisure at **Krabi Town**.
